PATIENT WAS ADMITTED WITH ABOVE MENTIONED COMPLAINTS. PATIENT UNDERWENT ALL RELEVANT AND ROUTINE INVESTIGATIONS. AFTER PRIOR COUNSELLING, CONSENT AND PREPARATION PATIENT UNDERWENT USG GUIDED LIVER ABSCESS ASPIRATION AND PIGTAIL INSERTION UNDER IV SEDATION BY DR. MEERA LUTHRA ON 03/06/2026. THE PATIENT IS CURRENTLY RECEIVING ANTIBIOTICS AND IV FLUIDS WITH PAINKILLERS. THE PLAN IS TO REPEAT USG AFTER 48 HOURS OF SURGERY TO LOOK FOR RESIDUAL COLLECTION AND FOR CLINICAL IMPROVEMENT.

THE PATIENT HAS PIGTAIL INSITU AND HAS RIGHT SIDED PLEURAL EFFUSION. PATIENT IS CURRENTLY STABLE, IS ACCEPTING ORALLY WELL AND VOIDING WELL.
